Subject: April 15 - May 31 Flow Schedule Under Article 37

Dear Messrs. Weis and Short:

You filed on June 25, 2007, a response to our letter dated May 30, 2007. We requested clarification of your April 18, 2007, letter to the California Department of Fish and Game (CDFG) and the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS), a copy of which was also sent to the Commission.

You provided an explanation of the April 18 letter and included considerable supporting information. You stated that the letter was the standard notification of the outcome of the initial flow scheduling process under Article 37 for determining flow allocation through May 31, 2007. You also explained that the flow schedule was developed in the manner prescribed by Article 37.

You are not required to file a flow schedule with the Commission unless you, the CDFG, and the USFWS agree to one that differs from the requirements of Article 37. Paragraph E of the Order Amending License issued July 31, 1996, requires you to notify

the Commission within 30 days of an agreement with the agencies for a revised flow schedule. Your April 18, 2007, letter to the resource agencies described a modified flow schedule, and appears to be the filing required by Paragraph E.

Future filings in compliance with this requirement should include a cover letter describing the nature of the filing, citation of the ordering paragraph that required it, and a copy of a letter, telephone record, or e-mail from each of the two resource agencies showing they agree with the revised flow schedule. Additionally, because you and the Modesto Irrigation District are co-licensees for this project, it would aid our efforts if the cover letter was prepared with the joint letterhead shown on other fisheries-related filings.
