SUMMARY

1. INTRODUCTION AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Allison Boucher advised that a grant has been approved to add another mile or so on river left.
 Bobcat Flat Phase III will start in July
- Fred Meyer advised that ½ mile downstream to the new bridge is currently at 65% of design phase.
- Amy Bailey advised that the Riverine Stewardship Program has opened up a new solicitation.
 Concept proposals can now be submitted through the Grants Portal. Public workshops will be held on 6/14/22 in Redding, 6/15/22 in Sacramento and on 6/17/22 in Calabasas.

- Discussion took place regarding including an area near Allison's property in future snorkel surveys.
